A Room to Heal completed 10 healing room projects in 2024, impacting 13 children and their families, as well as families who stay at the Ronald McDonald House of Central New York. The Ronald McDonald House of CNY serves nearly 700 children and family members each year, with about 30% residing in the Southern Tier. Thanks to our incredible volunteers, community partners, and donors who gave their time, materials, and generous discounts, we were able to save more than \$45,000 in project costs this year.

In 2025, we're excited to expand our reach through our new Comfort & Care Kits program. These kits allow us to support families who may not be ready for a full room project but still need comfort items or specific pieces to make their child's space more healing and supportive. This program helps us serve more children, meet families where they are, and continue spreading our mission of healing through care and connection. Each healing space, and now, each kit, represents the collective kindness of our community. When we come together, we create comfort, hope, and healing for children who need it most.

As we look ahead to the year to come, we are inspired to continue growing this work and reaching even more families in need.
